



R. MANMATHA's Biography

R. Manmatha is a Research Associate Professor at the Dept. of Computer Science, University of Massachusetts, Amherst. He is also a faculty member at the Center for Intelligent Information Retrieval. His research focuses on searching images and videos including images of printed and handwritten scanned documents. He has worked on the retrieval of trademark images and extensively on the automatic annotation and retrieval of images/videos. He, along with his students, created the first automatic retrieval system for historical handwritten manuscript images (specifically the manuscripts of George Washington). One of his current collaborations involves searching printed material in Indian languages. He spent summer 2005 working at Google on their book search effort. He is a co-founder and advisor to Snaptell Inc, a startup specializing in mobile image search.
